Alternative Housing Program Policy

Policy: The Alternative Housing Program is designed to assist the low-income, elderly who have qualified for the rehabilitation program, when the cost of repair or rehabilitation is not economically feasible.

Alternative Housing shall consist of a grant for a: Replacement Home - The type of dwelling the applicant receives is determined by the location (city, rural) of the existing structure site. The dwelling must be in accordance with all applicable federal, state and city regulations and ordinances.

The Applicant must sign an agreement to have the existing home demolished or a statement that the property will not be inhabited or that further housing services will not be requested for that property.

The size of the dwelling shall be a 2 or 3 bedroom depending on the size of the family.

The Muscogee (Creek) Nation Housing Division shall maintain a separate waiting list, apart from other housing waiting lists, for eligible applicants.

E. APPEAL PROCESS

A person who disagrees with the determination, concerning any part of this policy may file a written grievance of that determination with the Housing Deputy Director of the Muscogee (Creek) Nation in accordance with the Division of Housing's Grievance Policy.
